Trip Consent Form

To ease the burden of administration around trips for parents and carers, we have introduced a new trip consent form to provide permission for many of the trips we offer.

Once consent has been given, this will give pupils permission to attend all trips that the school deems to be local and low risk. These trips will be during the school day and free of charge. Trips included under this agreement include Worship in the Community, Sports Day and subject field work in the local area. Sports fixtures will also be included.

Staff will inform parents/carers of the trip in advance, including the timings and location of the visit. If you wish, you can withdraw your child from the trip by writing to the trip leader prior to the day of the trip.

Any trips that fall outside of school time, have a cost, or are deemed to be higher risk, will still require permission to be provided via ParentPay, for example residential trips or theatre visits in the evening.

Consent form for school trips and other off-site activities
